Reflection on POG "Here's why it matters."	<ul> <li>Student reflects personally on the value of POG in their life and how it might impact their future. They can identify a next step to continue growing.</li> </ul>

#### It's easy!






Regularly reflect on using the skills, how they are helpful, and how students know they are improving

#### An opportunity for students to:


- Share and celebrate their growth


